Sarah Burgamy, Psy.D. is the founder of a private practice in Denver, PhoenixRISE, with specialty offerings in identity development, sexual minority competency as well as transgender and gender variant issues with adults, adolescents and children. She is also a Senior Clinical Instructor at the University of Colorado, Anschutz Medical Campus, School of Medicine, Department of Psychiatry as well as the psychologist in the TRUE Center for Gender Diversity at Children’s Hospital Colorado. Dr. Burgamy has previously instructed courses as an adjunct assistant professor at the University of Denver in the Psy.D. program and the International Disaster Psychology Master’s program focused on arenas of development and culture, LGBTIQQ cultural competency, and cross-cultural analysis. Dr. Burgamy is the current Colorado Representative to the American Psychological Association (APA) Council of Representatives and a member of the APA Committee on Sexual Orientation and Gender Diversity. Dr. Burgamy has been a member of the Board of Directors for Urban Peak, a non-profit organization in Colorado serving youth experiencing homelessness or at risk of becoming homeless, since 2008.
